NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED REZONING OF 1008 AND 1016 MILWAUKEE AVENUE, TO PLANNED DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT FOR A COMMUNITY BASED RESIDENTIAL FACILITY (CBRF)

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that a public hearing will be held on a proposed amendment to the municipal zoning code to allow a Planned Development District (PDD) for the properties at 1008 and 1016 Milwaukee Avenue. If approved by the Common Council, the proposed PDD would permit renovation and reuse of the existing structure at 1016 Milwaukee Avenue, for conversion to a 16 bed Community Based Residential Facility (CBRF) for persons with long-term illnesses or disabilities. 1008 Milwaukee Avenue is currently a parking lot and will remain as parking for the proposed CBRF pursuant to a certain proposal submitted to the City. The public hearing will be held on Tuesday June 2, 2015 at 6:30 p.m. in the Common Council Chambers at the City Administration Building, 2424 15th Avenue South Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The Common Council will consider comments, and will determine whether to grant or deny the requested rezoning.
