OF THE COMMON COUNCIL  
Special Meeting

South Milwaukee  
August 2, 2011

The Special Meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor Zepecki at 5:30 p.m. On roll, all were present.

Mayor Zepecki read the call and turned the meeting over to Council President Bartoshevich who reviewed the guidelines to be followed in the interview process of the five aldermanic candidates. The candidates were each interviewed under those guidelines and asked the prepared set of questions in the following order: Dan Jones, Michael Moeller, Meghan Nitz, Frank Van Dusen, III, and Patricia Gruber.

After the interviews were completed there was a brief recess to allow interested parties to return to the Council Chambers. The Council cast ballots resulting in 3 votes for Mr. Van Dusen, 2 votes for Mr. Moeller, and 2 votes for Ms. Nitz. The floor was opened for additional discussion by the Council and a second ballot was cast with the same result. The floor was again opened for discussion and a third ballot was cast. The result of the third ballot was 4 votes for Mr. Van Dusen, 2 votes for Mr. Moeller, and 1 vote for Ms. Nitz. Mr. Van Dusen was declared to be the winner of the vote for the position of First District Alderperson until the Spring 2012 Election effective upon the administration of the Oath of Office.

At this time City Engineer Kyle Vandercar joined the meeting and there was discussion and review of the Storm Water Utility Budget, Capital Improvement Expenditures, and Debt Service Schedule.

Stoner/Navarro moved to adopt Resolution No. 11-16 amending the Storm Water Utility rates for tax year 2011 and subsequent years. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Stoner/Navarro moved to adopt Resolution No. 11-17 authorizing the transfer of funds to various accounts. On roll, all voted aye, motion carried.

Stoner/Navarro moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:42 p.m. All voted aye, motion carried.
