3. Amendment to contract with Bradford Contractors, LLC to replace 150 linear feet of sanitary sewer (installed circa 1923) and water main (installed circa 1907) in Davis Avenue as part of Carroll-Davis Storm Sewer Project, with new service laterals for outparcel development to be reimbursed by agreement with Wal-Mart Real Estate.
4. Rawson Avenue Storm Sewer – Schedule public hearing on contemplated special assessments to Caterpillar, (or underlying land owner) for a portion of the construction costs.
5. Agreement for purchase of real estate at 1301 **Nicholson** Avenue (2.24 acres) for storm water management as part of Nicholson-Pennsylvania Improvement Project, pursuant to determination of necessity approved under Resolution No. 11-24.
