NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

CONTRACT: FAIRVIEW AVENUE EBBS CREEK CULVERT REPLACEMENT

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received in the office of the City Clerk of the City of South Milwaukee at the Administration Building, 2424 15th Avenue, South Milwaukee, WI 53172 **until 11:00 a.m. Thursday, April 14, 2016**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read for the contract, officially known as: **FAIRVIEW AVENUE EBBS CREEK CULVERT REPLACEMENT**. The bid documents contain the contract bid quantities which include the following:

- Install 60" x 72" Precast Box Culvert – 300 L.F.
- Concrete (cast in place) Head Walls & Wing Walls
- 12", 15", & 24" Storm Sewer
- Storm Sewer Manholes and Inlets
- 8" Sanitary Sewer – 326 L.F.
- Sanitary Manholes
- 8" PVC Watermain – 440 L.F.
- 8" Gate Valves & Hydrant Assembly
- Concrete Curb, Sidewalk, Driveway Approaches
- 4 ¼" Asphalt Pavement – 1200 S.Y.
- Restoration

Work under this contract shall be substantially complete by June 24, 2016, except as allowed in the contract special provisions.

There is a non-refundable fee of twenty (\$20) dollars per set. Anyone desiring document sets by mail shall submit a fee in the amount of five (\$5) dollars per set in addition to the \$20 non-refundable fee to cover shipping and handling.

The minimum wage scale to be paid on this project by the contractor shall be in accordance with the minimum wage rates set forth in the Project Specifications as compiled by the State of Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development pursuant to 66.0903 Stats. The letting of this contract shall be subject to all applicable sections of Wisconsin Statutes. Determination No. 201600664.

Prequalification forms for 2016 are required to be on file in the Office of the City Engineer for all contractors and subcontractors at least seven days prior to bid opening. The City's decision as to qualification shall be final.

Proposal must be placed in a sealed opaque envelope addressed to: **"City Clerk, City of South Milwaukee, Wisconsin"** and marked **"Proposal for Fairview Avenue Ebbs Creek Culvert Replacement."** If the bid is sent by mail, the sealed envelope shall be enclosed in a separate mailing envelope with the notation **"Sealed**

Bid Enclosed” on the face thereof. **Bid results will be available on the City website at smwi.org following the bid opening.**

The City of South Milwaukee reserves the right to reject any or all bids and waive any informalities in the bidding. No bids shall be withdrawn after the opening of the bids without the consent of the Commission for a period of thirty (30) days after the scheduled time for closing bids.

All proposals must be submitted on a form provided for that purpose as issued within the Document Set, together with a certified check or a bid bond not less than five (5%) percent of the bid, payable to the City of South Milwaukee as a guarantee that, if the bid accepted, the bidder will execute and file the contract and a performance bond in the amount of one hundred (100%) percent of the total proposal price within ten (10) working days after the award of the contract. Failure to execute such contract and performance bond shall be cause for forfeiture of the check or bid bond as liquidated damages.
