**NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**

CONTRACT: CHICAGO AVENUE REHABILITATION THE OAK CREEK TO PINE STREET

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received in the office of the City Clerk of the City of South Milwaukee at the Administration Building, 2424 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue, South Milwaukee, WI 53172 **until 1:00 P.M. ON THURSDAY, APRIL 28, 2016** at which time they will be publicly opened and read for the contract, officially known as: **CHICAGO AVENUE REHABILITATION THE OAK CREEK TO PINE STREET**. The bid documents will contain the final contract quantities and will include the following:

- 24” Sanitary Sewer Manholes, and Laterals – 535 L.F.
- 8” Watermain, Valves, Hydrants, and Services – 950 L.F.
- Storm Sewer Upgrades/Inlet replacements
- Pavement Removal – 6250 S.Y.
- 9” Concrete Pavement – 5800 S.Y.
- Misc. Quantities of Curb, Sidewalk, Driveways, and Restoration
- Various Pavement Markings

It is anticipated that a contract will be authorized by the South Milwaukee Common Council on May 3, 2016. Work must be complete by October 15, 2016.

Document sets can be examined and obtained from the Office of the City Engineer, South Milwaukee City Administration Building, 2424 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue, South Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53172. There is a non-refundable fee of twenty (\$20) dollars per set. Anyone desiring document sets by mail shall submit a fee in the amount of five (\$5) dollars per set in addition to the \$20 non-refundable fee to cover shipping and handling.

Technical questions should be directed to Kyle Vandercar, City Engineer, [vandercar@smwi.org](mailto:vandercar@smwi.org), or (414)762-2222, ext. 136. Based on the Engineer’s estimate, the contract is anticipated to be in the range of \$675,000 to \$800,000.

The minimum wage scale to be paid on this project by the contractor shall be in accordance with the minimum wage rates set forth in the Project Specifications as compiled by the State of Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development pursuant to 66.0903 Stats. The letting of this contract shall be subject to all applicable sections of Wisconsin Statutes.

Prequalification forms for 2016 are required to be on file in the Office of the City Engineer for all contractors and subcontractors at least five days prior to bid opening. The City’s decision as to qualification shall be final.

Proposal must be placed in a sealed opaque envelope addressed to: **“City Clerk, City of South Milwaukee, Wisconsin” and marked “Proposal for Fairview Avenue Culvert Replacement.”** If the bid is sent by mail, the sealed envelope shall be enclosed in a separate mailing envelope with the notation **“Sealed Bid Enclosed”** on the face thereof. **Bid results will be available on the City website at [smwi.org](http://smwi.org) following the bid opening.**

The City of South Milwaukee reserves the right to reject any or all bids and waive any informalities in the bidding. No bids shall be withdrawn after the opening of the bids without the consent of the Commission for a period of thirty (30) days after the scheduled time for closing bids.

All proposals must be submitted on a form provided for that purpose as issued within the Document Set, together with a certified check or a bid bond not less than five (5%) percent of the bid, payable to the City of South Milwaukee as a guarantee that, if the bid accepted, the bidder will execute and file the contract and a performance bond in the amount of one hundred (100%) percent of the total proposal price within ten (10) working days after the award of the contract. Failure to execute such contract and performance bond shall be cause for forfeiture of the check or bid bond as liquidated damages.
