

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS
OF THE COMMON COUNCIL
Regular Meeting

South Milwaukee
September 18, 2012

The Regular Meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor Zepecki at 7:00 p.m. On roll call, all were present.

The meeting was prefaced by the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Mayor asked if there were any deletions to the agenda. There were none. Bartoshevich/Brooks moved to bring item number one under Reports of the Mayor to the front of the agenda. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bartoshevich/Brooks moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the September 4, 2012 Common Council meeting and approve them as drafted. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Reports of the Mayor, Bartoshevich/Brooks moved to receive and place on file the petition regarding the Mill Pond and forward to the Mayor's office and County Supervisor Jursik's office for review. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Finance Committee, Bukowski/Pieper moved to authorize the purchase of 456 tipper carts from Otto Environmental Systems in an amount not to exceed \$20,515.44. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Bukowski/Pieper moved to adopt Resolution No. 12-20 to amend the Administrative Fee Schedule to set the fee for tipper carts at \$48.00. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Bukowski/Pieper moved to approve the 2012 Revolving Funds as drafted and to authorize the proper city officials to proceed with the purchases. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Bukowski/Pieper moved to adopt Resolution No. 12-21 to set the 2013 fees for recycling and hazardous waste disposal. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Bukowski/Pieper moved to adopt Resolution No. 12-22 to set the 2013 hazardous waste disposal rate for units of five and greater. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Under Human Resources, Navarro/Stoner moved to recognize the city administrator's appointment of Sergio Gonzalez as a wastewater operator effective September 10, 2012 and to place him in the proper pay range. All voted aye, motion carried.

Navarro/Stoner moved to approve Officer Robert Wentz' tuition reimbursement request for 2013 pursuant to Article XVII of the current labor agreement. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Legislation & Permits Committee, Maass/Van Dusen moved to approve the agent change on the "Class A" license for the 2012-2013 period, issued to Mega Marts, LLC for the premise at 2931 S. Chicago Avenue (Pick 'n Save) and to authorize the City Clerk to issue the license upon receipt of all necessary fees and documents. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Plan Commission, Bartoshevich reminded the Council that the next Plan Commission meeting is scheduled for September 24, 2012 at 6:30 p.m. with a public hearing on the consideration of a Conditional Use Permit to build a 20 foot high detached garage at 515 Hawthorne Avenue, zoned R-B Residential, pursuant to Section 15.05 (F)(1)(b) of the Municipal Code.

There being no further business, Stoner/Navarro moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:39 p.m. All voted aye, motion carried.
