 - a. Testimony of Witnesses and arguments of Attorneys, etc. It is anticipated that all the testimony and arguments of Attorneys will be finished at this meeting. In the event it is necessary to continue to a later date, the Commission will adjourn to such later date to continue the hearing.
 - b. In the event all the testimony of Witnesses and arguments of Attorneys is completed early enough to permit deliberations by the Commission, the Commission may then adjourn to closed session for the purpose of deliberating on the hearing testimony pursuant to Wis. Stat. 19.85 (1)(a).
 - c. From time to time as necessary during the hearing the Commission may adjourn from the open hearing to closed session to deliberate on evidentiary questions and thereafter return to open session for the purpose of continuing the hearing. Such adjournments from the open hearing to closed deliberation session and return to open session for the purpose of clarifying questions may occur repeatedly, if necessary in the opinion of the Commission. In each case, the adjournment to a closed deliberation session will be pursuant to Wis. Stats. 19.85(1)(a).
 - d. At the conclusion of deliberations, the Commission will return to open session either to adjourn to a later date for further deliberations, if necessary, or to render their decision or to adjourn to a later date to render their decision at that later date.
