The Special Meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor Zepecki at 6:30 p.m. On roll, all were present except Stoner and Brooks who were excused.

Bartoshevich/Pieper moved for the Suspension of Rule 2.14 to permit giving an ordinance to amend Salary Ordinance No. 2059 to fix and establish the amount of salaries to be paid to the Code Enforcement Inspector its first, second and third readings at this meeting. Alderperson Brooks joined the meeting during the motion. On roll, all voted aye, motion carried. Bartoshevich/Pieper moved to give Ordinance No. 2072 to fix and establish the amount of salary to be paid to the Code Enforcement Inspector its first, second and third readings and adopt the ordinance and publish a summary in the official newspaper as required by law. On roll, all voted aye, motion carried.

Pieper indicated that item number two on the agenda should be deleted. It was so ordered.

Pieper/Bukowski moved to approve the application for a "Class B" Combination license for the sale of intoxicating liquors and fermented malt beverages for the 2013-2014 period filed by Mark Keishian for the premise at 800 Milwaukee Avenue and authorize the City Clerk to issue the license upon receipt of all necessary fees and documents. All voted aye, motion carried.

Pieper/Bukowski moved to approve the applications for a bartender license for the 2013-2014 period filed by Cami M. Blixt, 516 Milwaukee Avenue and Jennifer Lynn Radowski, 1641 Sherman Avenue, and to authorize the City Clerk to issue the licenses upon receipt of all necessary fees and documents. All voted aye, motion carried.



All voted aye, motion carried.

Pieper/Bukowski moved to adopt Resolution No. 13-06 to amend the Administrative Fee Schedule regarding fees charged for Street Department grass cutting on private property. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bartoshevich/Brooks moved to award a contract to Earth X, LLC for 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue Reconstruction (Milwaukee Avenue to Minnesota Avenue) in the amount of \$324,878.75 and have the City Engineer report recommended funding allocation to Finance Committee for approval. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bartoshevich/Brooks moved to approve the Conditional Use Permit to operate a child care early education center at 1327 Marshall Avenue (South Milwaukee Methodist Church) pursuant to the Plan of Operation submitted. All voted aye, motion carried.
