

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS
OF THE COMMON COUNCIL
Regular Meeting

South Milwaukee
May 20, 2014

The Regular Meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor Brooks at 7:00 p.m. On roll call, all were present.

The meeting was prefaced by the pledge of allegiance.

Mayor Brooks asked if there were any deletions to the agenda. There were none. Bartoshevich/Clark moved to bring the first three items under Reports of the Mayor to the front of the agenda. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bartoshevich/Clark moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the May 6, 2014 Common Council meeting and approve them as drafted. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Reports of the Mayor, Bartoshevich/Clark moved to receive and place on file, the South Milwaukee Police Department Annual Report. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bartoshevich/Clark moved to receive and place on file the South Milwaukee Fire Department Annual Report. All voted aye, motion carried.

Brooks presented a Proclamation to Chief Knitter recognizing Emergency Medical Services Week, May 18 -24, 2014.

Under President of the Council, Bartoshevich reminded the Council that the South Milwaukee Memorial Day ceremony will be held on May 26, 2014. Participants will gather at the American Legion Hall at 10:00 a.m. and proceed to 10th Avenue north to the War Memorial at 10th and Rawson Avenue for the recognition ceremony for veterans.

Bartoshevich/Clark moved to cancel the July 1, 2014 and August 5, 2014 Common Council meetings, due to holidays, events and vacations. The July 15, 2014 and August 19, 2014 meetings will remain the same. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Finance, Bukowski/Pieper moved to approve the financial reports for the various funds for the finalized Period 13 for 2013. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Human Resources, Navarro/Stoner moved to recognize the Police & Fire Commission's appointment of Jordan Schwehr as a police officer effective June 2, 2014, and place him in the proper pay range. All voted aye, motion carried.

Navarro/Stoner moved to recognize the Police & Fire Commission's appointment of Nathan Fager as a firefighter effective June 1, 2014, and place him in the proper pay range. All voted aye, motion carried.

Navarro/Stoner moved to recognize the Police & Fire Commission's appointment of Jeremy Fronczak as a firefighter effective June 2, 2014, and place him in the proper pay range. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Reports of the Mayor, Mayor Brooks informed Council that there will be movie nights at the Downtown Market on August 14th, August 21st, and October 9th.

Mayor Brooks informed the Council of plans to offer a free lunch and bouncing house in the park for the 4th of July festivities, hopeful this will bring down more families to celebrate in the park.

Under Plan Commission, Bartoshevich reminded the Council that the next meeting of the Plan Commission is scheduled for June 2, 2014 at 6:30 p.m.

Under Wastewater/Water Commission, Navarro/Stoner moved to authorize storm sewer work included with the contract for Sherman Avenue Watermain Relay in an amount not to exceed \$22,400 with funds from the Storm Water Utility Capital Fund. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

There being no further business, Navarro/Stoner moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:38 p.m. All voted aye, motion carried.
