

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS
OF THE COMMON COUNCIL
Regular Meeting

South Milwaukee
June 3, 2014

The Regular Meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor Brooks at 7:00 p.m. On roll call, all were present.

The meeting was prefaced by the pledge of allegiance led by Eagle Scout Bartlomiej Brzezicki.

Mayor Brooks asked if there were any deletions to the agenda. Bartoshevich/Clark moved to delete item number one under Reports of the Mayor and bring item number two to the front of the agenda. All voted aye, motion carried.

Mayor Brooks read and presented a proclamation to Bartlomiej Brzezicki honoring his achieving the rank of Eagle Scout.

Bartoshevich/Clark moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the May 20, 2014 Common Council meeting and approve them as drafted. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under President of the Council, Bartoshevich reminded the Council that the July 1, 2014 Council meeting has been cancelled and the July 15, 2014 meeting remains the same.

Under Finance, Bukowski/Pieper moved to approve the financial reports for the various funds for the period ending April 30, 2014. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bukowski/Pieper moved to approve the Schedule of Vouchers for the period ending May 31, 2014 in the amount of \$2,522,075.79. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Bukowski/Pieper moved to approve the purchase of six additional portable radios for the police department in an amount not to exceed \$10,000 with unexpended revolving funds. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Human Resources, Navarro/Stoner moved to recognize the city administrator's appointment of Ali E. Ali as a construction inspector (temporary/project specific employee) at a rate of \$16.00 per hour effective May 19, 2014. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Legislation & Permits Committee, Maass/Van Dusen moved to approve the applications for "Class A" Liquor and Class "A" Beer licenses for the 2014-2015 period, per the attached list, and authorize the city clerk to issue the license upon payment of all necessary fees and receipt of all documents. All voted aye, motion carried.

Maass/Van Dusen moved to approve the applications for "Class B" Combination licenses for the sale of fermented malt beverages and intoxicating liquor for the 2014-2015 period, per the attached list, and authorize the city clerk to issue the license upon payment of all necessary fees and receipt of all documents. All voted aye, motion carried.

Maass/Van Dusen moved to approve the applications for “Class B” Combination licenses for the sale of fermented malt beverages and intoxicating liquor for the 2014-2015 period, to include a beer garden per the attached list, subject to the following conditions: 1) No alcohol be served or consumed in the beer garden after 10:00 p.m., 11:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday; 2) Noise levels must be maintained in accordance with local ordinances at all times; 3) No glass bottles, glasses or glass beverage containers of any kind are permitted outdoors, and authorize the city clerk to issue the licenses upon payment of all necessary fees and receipt of all documents. All voted aye, motion carried.

Maass/Van Dusen moved to approve the applications for “Class B” Combination licenses for the sale of fermented malt beverages and intoxicating liquor for the 2014-2014 period, to include a permit for consumption on public property per the attached list, and authorize the city clerk to issue the licenses upon payment of all necessary fees and receipt of all documents. All voted aye, motion carried.

Maass/Van Dusen moved to approve the applications for Class “B” Beer and Class “C” Wine licenses for the 2014-2015 period, per the attached list, and authorize the city clerk to issue the license upon payment of all necessary fees and receipt of all documents. All voted aye, motion carried.

Maass/Van Dusen moved to approve the applications for Amusement Device Operator for the 2014-2015 period, as per the attached list, and authorize the city clerk to issue the license upon payment of all necessary fees and receipt of all documents. All voted aye, motion carried.

Maass/Van Dusen moved to approve the applications for Arcade licenses for the 2014-2015 period, per the attached list, and authorize the city clerk to issue the license upon payment of all necessary fees and receipt of all documents. All voted aye, motion carried.

Maass/Van Dusen moved to approve the applications for bartender licenses for the 2014-2015 period filed by Karamjit Sran, Richard A. Binkowski, Brent H. Oudeans, and Benjamin M. Martinez, and authorize the city clerk to issue the license upon payment of all necessary fees and receipt of all documents. All voted aye, motion carried.

Maass/Van Dusen moved to approve the applications for “Class B” Combination license for Café Sport Apollonia, Inc/Todi Peci, Agent for the premise at 1213 N. Chicago Avenue, 1st floor service/storage, Van Eimeren Kolonka Post 27, Paul Eckert, Agent, for the premise at 920 Monroe Avenue, 1st floor service/storage/hall, and George Bizub for the premise at 2703 S. Chicago Avenue, 1st floor service/storage/halls and basement storage and halls, and authorize the city clerk to issue the licenses upon payment of all necessary fees and receipt of all documents. All voted aye, motion carried.

Maass/Van Dusen moved to approve the application for Class “B” Beer license for PH Green Bay, LLC/Jeff Woo, Agent, for the premise at 124 N. Chicago Avenue, 1st floor service/storage, and authorize the city clerk to issue the license upon payment of all necessary fees and receipt of all documents. All voted aye, motion carried.

Maass/Van Dusen moved to approve the application for a Class “B” Beer and Class “C” Wine license filed by New China, LLC/Mei Yong Lin, Agent, for the premise at 1127 Milwaukee Avenue 1st floor service/basement storage and authorize the city clerk to issue the license upon payment of all necessary fees and receipt of all documents. All voted aye, motion carried.

Maass/Van Dusen moved to approve the application for a Junk Dealer license for the 2014-2015 period filed by Kathleen Lisowski for the premise at 1200 Minnesota Avenue and authorize the city clerk to issue the license upon payment of all necessary fees and receipt of all documents. All voted aye, motion carried.

Maass/Van Dusen moved for Suspension of the Rules to give an ordinance its first, second and third readings and this meeting and adopt the ordinance. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried. Maass/Van Dusen moved to give Ordinance No. 2085 to amend Section 24.01(D) of the Municipal Code prohibiting the possession of marijuana and controlled substances specified in Wis. Stats. 931.14(4) (tb) to (ty) its first, second and third readings and adopt the ordinance and publish a summary in the official newspaper as required by law. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Maass/Van Dusen moved to approve the revised Americans with Disabilities Act as drafted. All voted aye, motion carried.

Maass/Van Dusen moved to approve the Notice Under Americans with Disabilities Act as drafted. All voted aye, motion carried.

Maass/Van Dusen moved to approve the revised Anti-harassment and Retaliation Policy as drafted. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Reports of the Mayor, Mayor Brooks led discussion of a potential joint meeting with the South Milwaukee School Board on Wednesday, September 3, 2014.

Under Plan Commission, Bartoshevich reminded the Council that the next meeting of the Plan Commission is scheduled for June 23, 2014 at 6:30 p.m.

Under Miscellaneous Business, City Administrator Mayzik updated the Council on the property at 1315 Nicholson Avenue going into tax foreclosure. The out parcel is the property going into foreclosure, not the church and parking lot which has the same address as the out parcel facing Willow Avenue. There is no interest for future development and the city would not be interested in acquiring it.

There being no further business, Navarro/Stoner moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:41 p.m. All voted aye, motion carried.
