November 6, 2014

The Special Meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor Brooks at 6:00 p.m. On roll call, all were present except Van Dusen who was excused.

The meeting was prefaced by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Maass/Navarro moved to approve the application for bartender license for the 2014-2015 period filed by Brittany Seeger 120 W. Fairfield Dr. Oak Creek, and authorize the City Clerk to issue the license upon receipt of all necessary fees and documents. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Bartoshevich/Clark moved to receive and place on file, the report from the Plan Commission from their October 27, 2014 meeting. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bartoshevich/Clark moved to set a public hearing regarding the rezoning application submitted by Gorman & Company Inc. for reuse of existing facilities at 1610 Minnesota Avenue, 1610-1611 Manitoba Avenue, and 1611 Missouri Avenue (former St. Adalbert's campus), zoned R-B Residential, for a maximum 37 unit multi-family development for December 9, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council chambers in the City Administration building. On roll, Maass, Navarro, Stoner, Bukowski, Pieper, Clark, and Bartoshevich voted aye. Motion carried.

Stoner/Navarro moved to authorize the proper city officials to enter into a contract with Certpro Painters in an amount not to exceed \$4,300.00 for painting at 1115 College Avenue from funds from the contingency fund. On roll, Maass, Navarro, Stoner, Bukowski, Pieper, Clark, and Bartoshevich voted aye. Motion carried.

Bukowski/Pieper moved to approve the financial reports for the various funds for the period ending September 30, 2014. On roll, Maass, Navarro, Stoner, Bukowski, Pieper, Clark, and Bartoshevich voted aye. Motion carried.
