

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS
OF THE COMMON COUNCIL
Regular Meeting

South Milwaukee
December 16, 2014

The Regular Meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor Brooks at 7:00 p.m. On roll call, all were present.

The meeting was prefaced by the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Mayor asked if there were any deletions to the agenda. There were none.

Bartoshevich/Clark moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the Special Meeting of the Common Council on November 25, 2014 and approve them as drafted. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under President of the Council, Bartoshevich read a letter from the City Clerk informing the Council of receipt of a protest duly signed by owners of more than 20% of areas of land immediately adjacent to 1610-1611 Manitoba Avenue and 1610 Minnesota Avenue resulting in the need of three-fourths of the members of the council voting in favor of a change in zoning for it to pass.

Bartoshevich/Clark moved to deny the proposed rezoning of 1610 Minnesota Avenue and 1610-1611 Manitoba Avenue (former St. Adalbert's campus) for renovation and reuse of existing facilities for a 31-37 unit multi-family development. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Under Finance Committee, Bukowski/Pieper move to authorize the city treasurer to utilize the State Debt Collection (SDC) program through the Department of Revenue to collect funds owed to the city. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bukowski/Pieper moved to adopt Resolution No. 14-19 authorizing commencement of lawsuit to collect 2013 delinquent personal property taxes. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bukowski/Pieper moved to adopt Resolution No. 14-20 authorizing the insurance awards for the City of South Milwaukee for 2015. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Bukowski/Pieper moved to approve the financial reports for the various funds for the period ending October 31, 2014. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bukowski/Pieper moved to approve the Scheduled of Vouchers for the period ending November 30, 2014 in the amount of \$2,488,825.50. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Under Human Resources, Navarro/Stoner moved to recognize the city administrator's appointment of Mary Kosterman as a full-time public health nurse I effective December 29, 2014. All voted aye, motion carried.

Navarro/Stoner moved to approve the wastewater maintainer and public health nurse I job descriptions as drafted. All voted aye, motion carried.

Navarro/Stoner moved to recognize the city administrator's appointment of Darryl Gabriel as a water operator/mechanic effective January 6, 2015. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Legislation & Permits Committee, Maass/Van Dusen moved to adopt Resolution No. 14-21 to amend the Administrative Fee Schedule effective January 1, 2015. All vote aye, motion carried.

Under Public Works and Public Property, Van Dusen/Maass moved to adopt Resolution No. 14-22 requiring the repair of Union Pacific Railroad at-grade crossing at Rawson Avenue pursuant to Sec. 86.12 Wisconsin Statutes. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Plan Commission, Bartoshevich reminded the Council that the next meeting of the Plan Commission is scheduled for December 22, 2014 at 6:30 p.m.

Under Traffic Commission, Van Dusen/Maass moved for Suspension of the Rules pursuant to Sec. 2.11 of the municipal code. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried. Van Dusen/Maass moved that Ordinance No. 2096 to amend parking restrictions on the south side of Drexel Blvd., west of Sanctuary Drive be adopted and given its first, second, and third readings a summary ordinance be published in the official newspaper as required by law. All voted aye, motion carried.

Van Dusen/Maass moved to adopt Resolution No. 14-23 to revise the “Stop & Yield Master Map” to revise required stop from northbound/southbound on 11th Avenue at Madison Avenue, to westbound on Madison Avenue at 11th Avenue. All voted aye, motion carried.

There being no further business to discuss, Stoner/Navarro moved to adjourn at 7:15 p.m.
