

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS  
OF THE COMMON COUNCIL  
Regular Meeting

South Milwaukee  
March 15, 2016

The Regular Meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor Brooks at 7:00 p.m. On roll call, all were present.

The meeting was prefaced by the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Mayor asked if there were any deletions to the agenda. There were none.

Aldersperson Stoner asked for a moment of silence for the Kieck family.

Bartoshevich/Clark moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the Common Council meeting from the March 1, 2016 meeting and approve them as drafted. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under President of the Council, Aldersperson Pieper gave a summary report as Council Representative to the Library Board.

Bartoshevich reminded the Council that the Common Council meeting of April 5, 2016 has been canceled and rescheduled for March 29, 2016 due to the Spring Election. (Aldersperson Bukowski will give a report to the Board of Education at the March 29, 2016 meeting).

Bartoshevich updated Council on the South Milwaukee Earth Day Event to be held on April 30, 2016 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. There will be various types of recycling available and paper shredding at city hall. Supplies for the cleanup can be picked up at various locations throughout the city. All volunteers are invited to a hot dog lunch at the Senior Center.

Bartoshevich reminded the Council that a Public Hearing will be held on March 29, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. on a zoning amendment regarding creation of a Public Building Zone and Park Zone within the current zoning code.

Bartoshevich reminded the Council that members comments on the City's Comprehensive Draft Plan were due March 14, 2016.

Under Finance Committee, Stoner/Navarro moved to approve the financial reports for the period ending January 31, 2016. All voted aye, motion carried.

Stoner/Navarro moved to approve the Schedule of Vouchers for the period ending February 29, 2016 in the amount of \$1,474,856.77. All voted aye, motion carried.

Stoner/Navarro moved to authorize the proper city officials to notify the LGPIF of the city's withdrawal from the program effective May 1, 2016 and to authorize the proper city officials to finalize and execute a contract with MPIC in an amount not to exceed \$56,132. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Under Human Resources, Clark/Bartoshevich moved to accept the resignation of Public Safety Officer Luke Fenelon's effective April 3, 2016, with regrets. All voted aye, motion carried.

Clark/Bartoshevich moved to authorize that the upcoming part-time public safety officer vacancy and any subsequent vacancies be filled. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Legislation & Permits Committee, Pieper/Bukowski moved to give the proposed ordinance to repeal Section 4.19 of the Municipal Code, terminate the Community Development Authority transfer to the Plan Commission all duties and authorities previously exercised by the Community Development Authority, and alter the makeup of the Plan Commission its first reading and refer back to the Legislation & Permits Committee for further review. All voted aye, motion carried.

Pieper/Bukowski moved to introduce a resolution to create a Housing Authority. All voted aye, motion carried.

Pieper/Bukowski moved to give Ordinance No. 2123 to amend parts of Sec. 23.167 governing child sex offender residency restrictions its second and third readings and adopt the ordinance and publish a summary in the official newspaper as required by law to include the changes to Section 27.167-4 (d) as discussed. All voted aye, motion carried.

Pieper/Bukowski moved to give Ordinance No. 2124 to amend parts of Sec. 23.20 of the Municipal Code of Ordinances governing Pitbull dogs to remove obsolete provisions its second and third readings and adopt the ordinance and publish a summary in the official newspaper as required by law. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Plan Commission, Bartoshevich/Stoner moved that the Common Council schedule a Public Hearing on the City's Comprehensive Plan Update for April 21, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. or later, following the consultant's presentation to the Common Council at 6:30 p.m. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bartoshevich reminded Council that the next meeting of the Common Council is scheduled for March 28, 2016 at 6:30 p.m.

There being no further business to discuss, Stoner/Navarro moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:26 p.m.
