OF THE COMMON COUNCIL  
Regular Meeting

South Milwaukee  
November 2, 2021

The Regular Meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor Brooks at 7:00 p.m. On roll, all were present except Clark who was excused.

The meeting was prefaced by the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no deletions to the agenda.

Under President of the Council, Bartoshevich/Clark moved to adopt the items in the consent agenda: a) approval of minutes from the October 19 2021 Common Council meeting; b) approval of Mayor's appointment of James G. Davies to the Board of Appeals and; c) reappointment of Ernie Hooks to the Water/Wastewater Commission. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Human Resources Committee, Navarro/Backes moved to approve the Insurance Coordinator position description as drafted. All voted aye, motion carried.

Navarro/Backes moved to approve the Office Assistant position description as drafted. All voted aye, motion carried.

Navarro/Backes moved to suspend the rules to allow for giving the first, second and third readings to amend Ordinance No. 2211 and 2215 to fix and establish the amount of salaries, wages and certain benefits and allowances which shall be paid by the City of South Milwaukee to its Union Employees. On roll call, all voted aye. Motion carried. Navarro/Backes moved to adopt Ordinance No. 2220 to amend Ordinances No. 2211 and 2215 to fix and establish the amount of salaries, wages and certain benefits and allowances which shall be paid by the City of South Milwaukee to its Union Employees, and give the ordinance its first, second and third readings and publish a summary in the official newspaper as required by law. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Under Public Works & Public Property, Maass/Briesemeister moved to designate City owned property at 909 Menomonee for public purposes including storm water management and authorize a design services contract with Collins Engineers, Inc. in an amount of \$40,370; funded by storm water utility revenue. On roll call, all voted aye. Motion carried.


Under Plan Commission, Briesemeister stated that there may be a special meeting scheduled for November 9, 2021, which will be determined by staff if necessary.

Under Miscellaneous Business, Bartoshevich/Backes moved to go into closed session pursuant to Wis. Stats. 19.85(1) (g) for the purpose of conferring with legal counsel and Wis. Stats. 19.85 (1) (e) for competitive bargaining reasons specifically to discuss negotiation strategy regarding a potential contract with the City of Cudahy pertaining to the creation of a Joint Municipal Court. On roll call, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Pieper/Maass moved to return to open session and take no action on closed session items. All voted aye, motion carried.

There being no further business to discuss, Pieper/Bartoshevich moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:48 p.m. All voted aye, motion carried.
