

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 6/24/19 – 6/30/19



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **329** calls for service.

TRAFFIC COMPLAINT

An officer observed a vehicle driving without its headlights on and conducted a traffic stop in the 1500 Block of Milwaukee Avenue at 1:20 am on June 26th. As the officer approached the vehicle, it accelerated and left the area. The vehicle left the city limits after a brief pursuit and failed to stop for officers of the Cudahy Police Department and Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department as well. An investigation revealed the owner of the vehicle to be a 41-year-old Milwaukee woman and she was cited.

RETAIL THEFT

Officers were dispatched to a report of two individuals involved in taking a bottle of liquor from a business in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue without paying for it on June 25th. A 36-year-old Milwaukee man and a 31-year-old Milwaukee man who matched the descriptions given were located on a nearby Milwaukee County Transit bus. When confronted by store security, the 31-year-old man stated the 36-year-old man took the bottle of liquor. The 36-year-old man was arrested and issued a citation for Retail Theft.

Officers were dispatched to a report of an individual attempting to leave a business in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue without paying for items on June 28th. Store security reported the individual left in a vehicle and an officer on patrol in the area located that vehicle and conducted a traffic stop. The driver, a 39-year-old Milwaukee man, was also found to have two confirmed warrants with the St. Francis Police Department. Officers also located drug paraphernalia in the vehicle. He was arrested and taken to the police station where he was issued citations for Retail Theft and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. He was released on a Personal Recognizance Bond on the St. Francis Police Department warrants. A 31-year-old Cudahy woman who was a passenger in the vehicle was arrested and issued a citation for Obstructing after originally providing officers with false identification information.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

Officers were dispatched to a report of a possible intoxicated driver in a vehicle swerving in the traffic lane on June 29th. An officer located the vehicle in the 1300 Block of Michigan Avenue and the driver, a 34-year-old South Milwaukee woman, showed signs of impairment. She was arrested and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility before being referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a charge of Operating While Intoxicated-2nd Offense.

SUSPICIOUS VEHICLE

An officer located a vehicle parked and unoccupied in the 200 Block of Lake Drive on June 30th. Drug paraphernalia could also be seen inside the vehicle. A short time later, a 29-year-old Milwaukee man was located inside Grant Park after hours. He was warned and advised on the park hours and was arrested and issued a citation for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.
