

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 9/9/19 – 9/15/19



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **275** calls for service.

BURGLARY

A citizen reported over \$10,000 worth of power tools were stolen from a locked construction trailer in the 1600 Block of North Chicago Avenue during the final week of August and the first week of September. An investigation revealed some of the tools were taken to a pawn shop by a 34-year-old South Milwaukee man. A further investigation led to a search warrant being conducted at the residence of a 27-year-old South Milwaukee man where more tools were located. Both men were charged by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office with Burglary-Party to a Crime. A 28-year old Cudahy man was also arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a Burglary charge.

DAMAGE TO PROPERTY

Officers were dispatched to the 1400 Block of Manitoba Avenue on September 14th for a report of an individual breaking a car window. Upon arrival, officers spoke with a 42-year-old Milwaukee woman and a 33-year-old South Milwaukee man. The woman admitted to breaking a window on the South Milwaukee man's car in retaliation for an incident that had occurred in the city of Milwaukee. She was arrested and issued a citation for Criminal Damage to Property.

DRUG INVESTIGATION

Officers were dispatched to the 100 Block of Brookdale Drive on September 15th for a welfare check after a male called and stated a female was threatening to harm herself. Upon arrival, officers located numerous items of drug paraphernalia and entered a residence to conduct the welfare check. Heroin and other drug paraphernalia was observed inside the residence and a search warrant was obtained. A 57-year old South Milwaukee man, a 54-year old South Milwaukee woman, and a 39-year-old South Milwaukee man were all arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Possession of a Controlled Substance-Heroin.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

On September 14th, a caller reported a woman appeared to be passed out in a vehicle in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue and officers were sent to the area. The woman woke up prior to the officers' arrival and began to drive away. An officer located the vehicle and initiated a traffic stop in the 1200 Block of North Chicago Avenue after observing the vehicle improperly change lanes. The driver, a 39-year old South Milwaukee woman, showed signs of impairment. She advised the officer of a firearm in the vehicle which was located by the officer. The woman did not have a valid CCW permit. She was arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Operating While Intoxicated and Carrying a Concealed Weapon.

Officers were dispatched to a minor motor vehicle accident at South Chicago and Columbia Avenues on September 11th. A 60-year old Cudahy man stated his vehicle was struck by another vehicle and the other driver involved appeared intoxicated. Officers spoke with a 56-year old South Milwaukee man who showed signs of impairment. He was arrested and issued citations for Operating While Intoxicated-First Offense and Prohibited Blood-Alcohol Concentration.
