

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 1/27/20 – 2/2/20



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **229** calls for service.

ARREST WARRANT

On February 2nd, an officer initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle without license plates near 13th and Columbia Avenues. The driver, a 43-year-old Milwaukee man was issued a citation for Operating After Revocation and was warned on the vehicle registration. The passenger, a 30-year-old Milwaukee woman, was found to have a confirmed warrant with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office. She was arrested and taken to the police station where she was turned over to Milwaukee County Sheriff's deputies.

On January 28th, officers received an apprehension request from the Wisconsin Department of Corrections for an individual wanted on a Probation Violation warrant. Officers located the individual, a 38-year-old South Milwaukee man, in the 1600 Block of Missouri Avenue and confirmed the warrant. He was arrested and taken to the police station before being transported to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility on the warrant.

On February 1st, a 23-year-old Milwaukee woman who came to the police station was found to have a confirmed warrant with the Waukesha County Sheriff's Office. She was arrested and turned over to Waukesha County Sheriff's deputies on the warrant.

RETAIL THEFT

On February 1st, officers were dispatched to a report of an individual leaving a business in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue without paying for items. Officers spoke with a 45-year-old Milwaukee woman who was being detained by store security after leaving the last point of sale with the items. She was arrested and taken to the police station where she was issued a citation for Retail Theft.

On January 31st, officers were dispatched to a report of an individual leaving a business in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue without paying for an item. Officers located a 30-year-old Milwaukee man near the intersection of South Chicago Avenue and Drexel Boulevard who matched the description given by the caller. Officers viewed surveillance video that showed the man leave the business with an item concealed in his coat. He was arrested and taken to the police station where he was issued a citation for Retail Theft.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

On January 31st, a motorist called to report a vehicle driving recklessly near Forest Hill and South Chicago Avenues. Officers were dispatched and located the vehicle parked improperly in the 2700 Block of North Chicago Avenue. The driver, a 65-year-old Racine man, showed signs of impairment. He was arrested and taken to the Milwaukee Criminal Justice Facility before being referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Operating While Intoxicated-2nd Offense and Operating with a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration-2nd Offense.

On February 1st, officers were dispatched to a business in the 2300 Block of 10th Avenue for a report of vehicle parked and occupied for an extended period of time. Officers located the vehicle and found two male subjects asleep inside. Officers were able to wake up both men. The driver, a 26-year-old Milwaukee man, showed signs of impairment and he was arrested and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility before being referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Operating While Intoxicated-2nd Offense and Operating with a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration-2nd Offense. The passenger, a 26-year-old Oak Creek man, was arrested and issued a citation for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia after drug paraphernalia was located on his person.
