

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 1/21/19 – 1/27/19



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **293** calls for service.

RECOVERED STOLEN VEHICLE

A vehicle reported stolen from the city of Racine was located in the parking lot of a business in the 100 Block of North Chicago Avenue at 12:16 pm on January 26th. Surveillance video showed the vehicle enter the lot the previous evening occupied by a male and a female. The owner of the vehicle was notified to pick the vehicle up from the lot and the information was turned over to the Racine Police Department for their investigation.

SUSPICIOUS VEHICLE

An alert citizen reported a suspicious vehicle parked and occupied by numerous individuals in the 200 Block of Marshall Avenue at 10:11 pm on January 23rd. Upon arrival, officers noticed a strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. A 20 year old South Milwaukee man and two 18 year old Milwaukee men were issued citations for Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor and two juveniles were issued citations for Possession of Marijuana. All were taken to the police station where they were issued the citations and the adults were released while the juveniles were picked up by their parents.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

A 27 year old South Milwaukee man was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct after officers were dispatched to a report of an individual urinating in the street in the 1500 Block of Rawson Avenue at 6:19 pm on January 26th. Officers located the man who was highly intoxicated. He was taken to the police station and placed in a holding cell due to his level of intoxication before being issued the citation and released.

Officers were dispatched to a report of individuals arguing in the 3300 Block of Marina Road at 11:34 pm on January 22nd and that one subject was armed with a knife and another with a hammer. Upon arrival it was learned the argument was between roommates regarding rent and no weapons were observed. The subjects continued to argue loudly in the presence of officers. A 33 year old South Milwaukee woman, a 25 year old Sussex woman, a 25 year old Oak Creek man, a 41 year old Jackson man, and a 41 year old South Milwaukee woman were all issued citations for Disorderly Conduct.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

A citizen reported an impaired driver in a vehicle what was swerving and struck a telephone pole near Nicholson and Rawson Avenues just after 9:00 pm on January 21st. Officers located the vehicle and conducted a traffic stop near Drexel and Nicholson Avenues. Tire tracks and debris were located near the telephone pole and the vehicle had damage consistent with striking an object and wood lodged in the rims. A 62 year old St. Francis man was arrested and issued citations for Operating While Intoxicated-First Offense, Prohibited Alcohol Concentration, and Hit and Run Property Damage.
