

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 2/10/20 – 2/16/20



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **285** calls for service.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

On February 14th, officers were dispatched to a report of an individual refusing to leave a residence in the 800 Block of Lakeview Avenue. Officers spoke with a 27-year-old St. Francis woman who was intoxicated. She was advised to leave the residence and was eventually arrested after continuously refusing to do so. She was taken to the police station where she was issued a citation for Trespassing before being released so a sober, responsible adult.

WARRANT ARREST

On February 15th, an officer initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle with expired registration in the 700 Block of Hawthorne Avenue. While identifying the occupants in the vehicle, it was discovered the passenger, a 40-year-old South Milwaukee man, held a confirmed warrant with Kenosha Joint Services. The man was arrested and taken to the police station where a friend of the man posted bond on the warrant. He was provided a court date for Kenosha Joint Services and was released.

On February 15th, an officer initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle for a stop sign violation near the Oak Creek Parkway and Oak Street. The driver, a 19-year-old South Milwaukee man was found to have a confirmed warrant with the Cudahy Police Department. The man signed a Personal Recognizance bond and was provided a court date on the Cudahy warrant.

On February 11th, officers were dispatched to the 1100 Block of Marquette Avenue for a report of a suspicious person. Officers spoke with a 42-year-old South Milwaukee woman who was found to have a confirmed felony warrant with the Milwaukee Police Department. The woman was also in possession of drug paraphernalia and she was arrested. She was issued a citation for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia before being turned over to officers from the Milwaukee Police Department on the warrant.

On February 11th, An officer on patrol spoke with a 29-year-old South Milwaukee man in the 1500 Block of Rawson Avenue. The man was found to have confirmed warrants with the Greenfield Police Department and the Oak Creek Police Department. The man was arrested and taken to the police station where he signed Personal Recognizance bonds on both the Greenfield Police Department and Oak Creek Police Department warrants.

On February 13th, officers were dispatched to a report of an individual inside a business in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue who was previously banned from the business due to prior thefts. Officers spoke with a 46-year-old South Milwaukee woman who was found to have a confirmed warrant with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office. She was arrested and taken to the police station where she was turned over to Milwaukee County Sheriff's deputies on the warrant.

On February 16th, officers were dispatched to a report of a wanted individual inside a residence in the 1600 Block of Marion Avenue. Officers spoke with a 40-year-old South Milwaukee man who had a confirmed warrant with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office. The man was arrested and taken to the police station where he was turned over to Milwaukee County Sheriff's deputies on the warrant.
