RE: Milwaukee Avenue Improvements (9<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup>) Update  
Contract continuation

Dear Business Owner, Property Owner, or other interested party,

With spring weather, Phase I of the Milwaukee Avenue Improvements has been re-initiated. As a reminder this phase of work includes:

- Install storm sewer, inlets and repairs.
- Remove and replace areas of designated curb and gutter, and install curb for new curb ramps.
- Remove and replace areas of designated curb and concrete pavement. Install new curb ramps at specified intersections. (10<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup>)
- Remove existing traffic signals at 10<sup>th</sup> and Milwaukee intersection and install new equipment.
- Modification of traffic signals at the intersection of Milwaukee Avenue and 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue to remove and install new signal heads and poles (to replace banner poles).
- Install pavement marking for new signals and crosswalks, and bike lane on each side.

**Starting Friday, April 10<sup>th</sup>, Milwaukee Avenue will be closed and fully barricaded to traffic from the west side of 10<sup>th</sup> to the east side of 11<sup>th</sup>. The sidewalk will remain open. Traffic will be detoured to 11<sup>th</sup> and Madison. Construction will take 10-14 days, depending on weather or unforeseen conditions.**
