

RESOLUTION NO. 20-08

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FINANCIAL RELIEF TO CERTAIN ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH LICENSING APPLICANTS FOR THE 2020-2021 LICENSING PERIOD

WHEREAS, COVID-19, a novel strain of the coronavirus, was detected in December, 2019, and has subsequently spread throughout numerous countries and the United States, including Wisconsin, causing State officials to issue Emergency Order #12 on March 24, 2020 otherwise known as the “Safer at Home Order”; and

WHEREAS, under the Safer at Home Order, all restaurants and bars are prohibited from onsite dining/service, which has caused many licensees to drastically modify their operations, reduce staff or close completely; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council for the City of South Milwaukee is committed to financially assisting applicants for the following environmental health licensing fees for the 2020-2021 licensing period by paying for a portion of the licensing fees from City contingency funds; and

WHEREAS, without this intervention, estimated fees for licenses listed below, for the 2020-2021 period, would total \$29,504.00. After this Resolution takes effect, license holders would pay an estimated total of \$14,752.00, a 50% reduction, and the City of South Milwaukee will cover the balance for the 2020-2021 licensing period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council for the City of South Milwaukee, Wisconsin, as follows:

1. Licensed applicants in the listed categories below who will be renewing their 2020-2021 restaurant permits will pay 50% of their respective fee pursuant to the current Administrative Fee Schedule for the 2020-2021 licensing period. The City of South Milwaukee shall pay the remaining balance due, from the contingency fund.
