Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received in the office of the City Clerk of the City of South Milwaukee at the Administration Building, 2424 15th Avenue, South Milwaukee, WI 53172 **until 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday March 31, 2021** at which time they will be publicly opened and read for the above public works improvement contract. This project will have 2 base bid proposals as summarized below. Qualified contractors can submit proposals for Part A or Part B, or both Part A & B.

The document set describes items and final quantities for bid each proposal. It is anticipated that contracts will be awarded by the South Milwaukee Common on April 7, 2021. Part A shall be complete by July 15, 2021 and Part B by September 15, 2021, unless otherwise allowed by the Engineer.

Prequalification forms for 2021 are required to be on file in the Office of the City Engineer for all contractors and subcontractors at least seven (7) days prior to bid opening. Forms are available from the Engineer’s Office upon request or on the City’s website:

<https://wi-southmilwaukee.civicplus.com/DocumentCenter/View/239/Prequalification-Application-PDF>. The Common Council's decision as to qualification shall be final.

Proposal must be placed in a sealed opaque envelope addressed to: **“City Clerk, City of South Milwaukee, Wisconsin” and marked “Proposal for Michigan Avenue, 12th to 15th, Part A or Part B”**. If the bid is sent by mail, the sealed envelope shall be enclosed in a separate mailing envelope with the notation **“Sealed Bid Enclosed”** on the face thereof.

The City of South Milwaukee reserves the right to reject any or all bids and waive any informalities in the bidding. No bids shall be withdrawn after the opening of the bids without the consent of the City of South Milwaukee, Wisconsin, for a period of thirty (30) days after the scheduled time for closing bids.

All proposals must be submitted on a form provided for that purpose as issued within the Document Set, together with a certified check or a bid bond not less than five (5%) percent of the bid, payable to the City of South Milwaukee as a guarantee that, if the bid accepted, the bidder will execute and file the contract and a performance bond in the amount of one hundred (100%) percent of the total proposal price within ten (10) working days after the award of the contract. Failure to execute such contract and performance bond shall be cause for forfeiture of the check or bid bond as liquidated damages.

This project is partially funded by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation through the Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP).
