It is anticipated that the Common Council will award a contract on June 20, 2017. Work under this contract shall start no earlier than July 10 and be complete by August 24, 2017, except for restoration items as described in the contract special provisions.

There is a non-refundable fee of twenty (\$20) dollars per set. Anyone desiring document sets by mail shall submit a fee in the amount of five (\$5) dollars per set in addition to the \$20 non-refundable fee to cover shipping and handling.

Prequalification forms for 2017 are required to be on file in the Office of the City Engineer for all contractors and subcontractors at least seven days prior to bid opening. The City's decision as to qualification shall be final.

Proposal must be placed in a sealed opaque envelope addressed to: "City Clerk, City of South Milwaukee, Wisconsin" and marked "Proposal for 5TH Avenue Culvert Replacement." If the bid is sent by mail, the sealed envelope shall be enclosed in a separate mailing envelope with the notation "Sealed Bid Enclosed" on the face thereof. Bid results will be available on the City website at smwi.org following the bid opening.

The City of South Milwaukee reserves the right to reject any or all bids and waive any informalities in the bidding. No bids shall be withdrawn after the opening of the bids without the consent of the Commission for a period of thirty (30) days after the scheduled time for closing bids.

All proposals must be submitted on a form provided for that purpose as issued within the Document Set, together with a certified check or a bid bond not less than five (5%) percent of the bid, payable to the City of South Milwaukee as a guarantee that, if the bid accepted, the bidder will execute and file the contract and a performance bond in the amount of one hundred (100%) percent of the total proposal price within ten (10) working days after the award of the contract. Failure to execute such contract and performance bond shall be cause for forfeiture of the check or bid bond as liquidated damages.
